**SouthGate Mobility Partners Holds Public Meeting for State Highway (SH) 183 from
Wilshire Dr./Reliance Pkwy to east of American Blvd/Bear Creek Pkwy**
Public involvement encouraged – comments, concerns and suggestions welcome

BEDFORD (March 16, 2015) — SouthGate Mobility Partners (SGMP) will conduct a Public Meeting to present design changes in Segment 2E on the west end of the Midtown Express project. The design changes in consideration are on State Highway (SH) 183 from Wilshire Dr./Reliance Pkwy to just east of American Blvd/Bear Creek Pkwy. The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 19, 2015 from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. at First Baptist Church Euless – Campus West Facility, 205 N. Industrial Blvd., Bedford, TX 76201.

The \$847 million Midtown Express project area includes SH 183 from Wilshire Dr./Reliance Pkwy to Interstate 35 East (I-35E), Loop 12/I-35E from Spur 408 to I-35E, and SH 114 from International Parkway to SH 183.

This public meeting will be in an open house, "come and go" format, with no formal presentations. Maps, photo simulations, drawings and other information about the project will be on display. Attendees will have the opportunity to provide the project team with written comments or questions.
